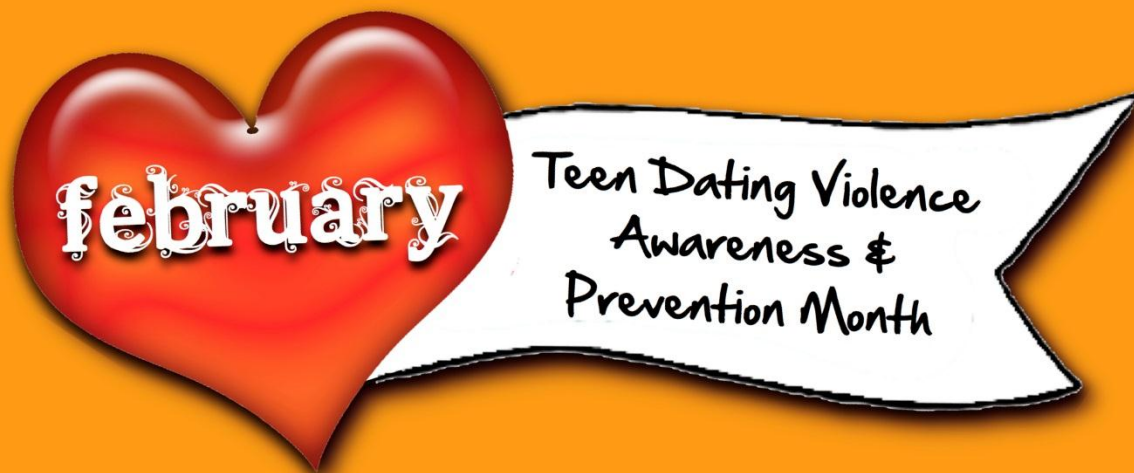

What is **TEEN DATING VIOLENCE?**

Teen Dating Violence is the act or threat of violence by one member of an unmarried couple on the other member within a dating relationship. This includes any form of sexual, physical, and/or verbal or emotional abuse.





What **T D V** Looks like . . .

- ◆ Abusive relationships are based on the **power and control** the abuser has over the victim.
- ◆ **possessive behavior, insults, jealous accusations, yelling, humiliation, and low-level violence like pushing or pulling hair.**



Different forms of

T D V :

- ◆ psychological
- ◆ sexual
- ◆ physical
- ◆ verbal
- ◆ cyber
- ◆ economic




6 signs of a **PSYCHOLOGICAL ABUSIVE RELATIONSHIP**

- # 1 Your partner puts you down verbally, in public and/or private.
- # 2 Your partner either withholds or demands physical intimacy.
- # 3 There is an attempt on your partner's part to control your activities.
- # 4 Your partner limits or attempts to limit your contact with family and friends.
- # 5 Your partner implies non-physical punishment or threats if you do not comply with his demands and desires.
- # 6 You feel crazy, inferior, less intelligent, or question reality because of the things your partner says about you.

SEXUAL ABUSE STATISTICS

- ◆ 1 in 4 girls (25%) are sexually abused by the age of 18.
- ◆ 1 in 6 boys (17%) are sexually abused by the age of 18.



VERBAL ABUSE

- ◆ Name Calling
- ◆ Threats
- ◆ Insults
- ◆ hyper-critical
- ◆ Yelling



CYBER ABUSE

- ◆ Obsessive texting
- ◆ Sexting (snap chat)
- ◆ Social media (FB Instagram twitter voxer)
- ◆ Video Chat (Facetime/oovoo)

FINANCIAL ABUSE

- ◆ Always insisting on paying

- ◆ Always requiring other party to pay
